FORM OF NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given, in compliance with requirements of Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, that the Finance and Personnel Committee of the Common Council of the City of La Crosse, Wisconsin, will hold a public hearing at \_\_\_\_\_ on \_\_\_\_\_, 2016, in the Council Chambers at the City Hall, 400 La Crosse Street, La Crosse, Wisconsin, regarding the proposed issuance of City of La Crosse, Wisconsin, Industrial Development Revenue Bonds, Series 2016 (DuraTech Industries, Inc. Project), in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$7,500,000, pursuant to Section 66.1103 of the Wisconsin Statutes, to finance a project on behalf of Commercial Properties Partners LLC, a Wisconsin limited liability company, and/or DuraTech Industries Inc., a Wisconsin corporation, and/or a related entity, and/or a limited liability entity to be formed (collectively, the "Borrower"). The bonds are special, limited obligations of the City of La Crosse and do not constitute a charge against its general credit or taxing powers.

The project consists of financing the (i) construction of an approximately 47,000 square foot addition to the Borrower's existing approximately 73,230 square foot facility located at 3216 Commerce Street in the City of La Crosse, Wisconsin (the "Facility") which is operated by DuraTech Industries, Inc. and used to manufacture custom labels, (ii) acquisition and installation of equipment at the Facility, and (iii) payment of certain professional costs and costs of issuance (collectively, the "Project").

At the hearing, all persons will be afforded a reasonable opportunity to express their views, both orally and in writing, on the proposed bonds and the location and nature of the Project proposed to be financed. Comments made at the public hearing are for the consideration of the Finance and Personnel Committee of the Common Council of the City of La Crosse, but do not bind any legal action to be taken by it.
