GENERAL LOCATION: Intersection of Liberty & Gould Streets			
Report:			
& Gould Streets, wl	hich is currently u	ncontrolled. Condition	control at the intersection of Liberty ns, including sight distance, crash conditions per existing criteria.
However, the configuration of the streets is unique because Liberty (to the south) and Gould (to the east) each end in a cul-de-sac beyond the intersection. To establish proactive guidance at the intersection, the Board of Public Works could approve 2-way YIELD control. It would be recommended that the signs be arranged for North-South traffic to yield to east-west traffic.			
WHEREAS , Section 44-39 of the City of La Crosse Municipal Code of Ordinances provides that after obtaining a report and recommendation of the Traffic Engineer, the Chief of Police shall forward recommendations and appropriate orders to the Board of Public Works.			
AND WHEREAS , the Findings of the Traffic Engineer state the public interest, convenience, and necessity, the Chief of Police hereby Orders the above traffic alterations, to wit:			
Establish midblock crosswalk on Frontage Rd, approx. 250' south of Sunset Ln			
NOW, THEREFORE , the Board of Public Works hereby approves the aforementioned traffic alteration, and City staff is hereby authorized to effect said changes.
