AN AMENDED ORDINANCE to create Section 115-320 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of La Crosse to designate the Historic Overlay District known as the Downtown Commercial Local Historic District and to create the design review standards for the district.
Please take notice that the above Ordinance was adopted by the Common Council of the City of La Crosse on January 8, 2015. A summary of the subject matter and main points of the ordinance is as follows.
* Create the Downtown Commercial Historic District generally described as the area between State Street, 2nd Street, Jay Street and the east side of 5th Avenue.
* Create design review standards for the District.

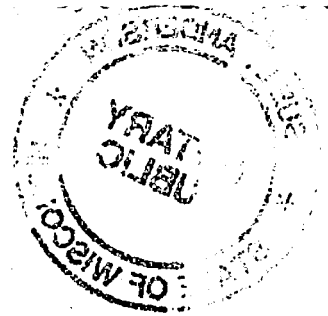
