It is expedient and necessary and for the best interest of the City of La Crosse and for the property affected thereby, that: the Sewer and Water Main Installation on 14th Street from Mississippi St to Market Street he improved at the expense. Street be improved at the expense of the property benefited, by the construction of concrete alley pav-

ing.

The Council exercises its police power to levy special assessments upon property for benefits conferred upon such property.

The report of the Board of Public

Works, incorporated herein as if fully set forth herein, including the plans and specifications and assessments set forth therein, is adopted and approved.

The Board of Public Works shall advertise for bids and supervise construction of the improvements in accordance with the report hereby adopted and take such other and proper steps to effectuate this resolution. Sworn 1

Payment for the improvements shall be made by assessing the entire cost to the property benefited as indicated in the report.

The Council determines that as-The Council determines that assessments shown on the report represent an exercise of the police power for the health, safety and general welfare of the City and its inhabitants and have been determined on a reasonable basis and are hereby confirmed.

Assessments levied against those properties for water shall be delayed for 10 years.

for 10 years.

Assessments levied against those properties for sanitary sewer shall be delayed for 10 years, or until the

be delayed for 10 years, or until the sanitary sewer is connected to the new lateral- whichever comes first. Assessments may be paid in cash or shall be payable over a period of ten years or fifteen years to the City Treasurer. Installments shall be placed on the next tax roll after the due date for collection and shall bear interest at the rate established by the Council per annum on the unpaid balance from January 1st of the year following the levy.

The City Clerk shall provide notices in accordance with City Ord. 38-1.
