

**NOTICE OF HEARING ON  
AMENDMENT TO ZONING RESTRICTION**

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Common Council of the City of La Crosse, by its Judiciary & Administration Committee, will hold a public hearing on a proposed ordinance change in the zoning code as follows:

**An Ordinances of the City of La Crosse transferring certain property from the Single Family Dwelling District to the Public/Semi-Public District allowing new fire station at 1532-34 and 1540 Liberty St. and 1539, 1543, 1547 and 1553 Charles Street.**

**Property is presently used for: Four single family homes and two duplexes.**

**Property is proposed to be used for: New fire station.**

**Rezoning is necessary because: A fire station is not an approved use in current zoning.**
