NOTICE TO ELECTORS OF THE CITY OF LA CROSSE, WISCONSIN
 TAKE NOTICE that the Common Council of the City of La Crosse, Wisconsin (the "Issuer"), at a regular meeting held at City Hall, 400 La Crosse Street, La Crosse, Wisconsin, on November 10, 2016, adopted an Initial Resolution pursuant to Section 66.1103 of the Wisconsin Statutes, as amended, expressing the intention to issue not to exceed \$7,500,000 of industrial development revenue bonds of the Issuer (the "Bonds") on behalf of Commercial Properties Partners, LLC, a Wisconsin limited liability company, and/or, DuraTech Industries, Inc., a Wisconsin corporation, and/or a related entity, and/or a limited liability entity to be formed (collectively, the "Borrower"). The Borrower desires to complete a project to be owned by the Borrower and operated by DuraTech Industries, Inc., to manufacture custom labels, consisting of financing the (i) construction of an approximately 47,000 square foot addition to the Borrower's existing approximately 73,230 square foot facility located at 3216 Commerce Street in the City of La Crosse, Wisconsin (the "Facility"), (ii) acquisition and installation of equipment at the Facility, and (iii) payment of certain professional costs and costs of issuance, (collectively, the "Project"). The Borrower has represented that the total number of full-time equivalent jobs which will be created by the Project is 30 jobs within three years of project completion.
 Pursuant to Section 66.1103 of the Wisconsin Statutes, all requirements for the Project to be subject to the contracting requirements of Section 66.1103 of the Wisconsin Statutes are represented that it is able to negotiate satisfactory arrangements for completing the Project and that the Issuer's interests are not prejudiced thereby.
 THE BONDS SHALL NEVER CONSTITUTE AN INDEBTEDNESS OF THE ISSUER, NOR SHALL THE BONDS GIVE RISE TO ANY PECUNIARY LIABILITY OF THE ISSUER, NOR SHALL THE BONDS BE A CHARGE AGAINST THE GENERAL CREDIT OR TAXING POWERS OF THE ISSUER. RATHER, THE BONDS SHALL BE PAYABLE SOLELY FROM THE REVENUES AND OTHER AMOUNTS TO BE DERIVED PURSUANT TO THE REVENUE AGREEMENT RELATING TO SAID PROJECT TO BE ENTERED INTO BETWEEN THE ISSUER AND THE BORROWER.
 The Initial Resolution may be inspected in the office of the City Clerk at 400 La Crosse Street, La Crosse, Wisconsin, during business hours.
 TAKE FURTHER NOTICE THAT THE ELECTORS OF THE CITY OF LA CROSSE MAY PETITION FOR A REFERENDUM ON THE QUESTION OF THE BOND ISSUE. Unless within thirty (30) days from the date of the publication of this Notice a petition signed by not less than five percent (5%) of the registered electors of the City of La Crosse is filed with the City Clerk requesting a referendum on the question of the issuance of the Bonds, the Issuer will issue the Bonds without submitting the proposition for the electors' approval; such petition is filed as effective if the Bonds are not so petitioned and approved by a majority of the electors of the City of La Crosse, or if the petition is filed at a general or special election.

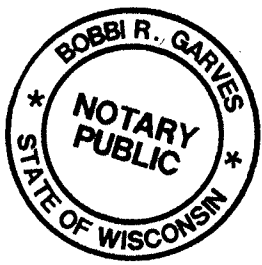
