AN ORDINANCE to amend Sub-section 115-110 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of La Crosse transferring certain property from the Special Multiple District to the Special Multiple District requesting removal of a pre-existing restrictive covenant at 2415 Cass St.
Proposed rezoning is necessary because: Zoning District will not change; rezoning is necessary in order to remove a restrictive covenant restricting the building to 3 stories and 29 units and being occupied solely by elderly and/or handicapped persons.
