

Resolution supporting Harbor Assistance Program application for Isle La Plume Dock Repairs.

### RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Three Year Harbor Development Statement of Intentions describes proposed improvements which are in the best interest of the La Crosse Municipal Harbor; and

WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Department of Transportation, in accord with state statute, requires a statement of project intentions from local units of government intending to apply for federal and/or state aid for harbor related work of any type within the next three years; and

WHEREAS, we have carefully reviewed the estimated project costs, funding sources, physical location, and alternatives to the proposed project(s); and

WHEREAS, the total local matching funds required for projects indicated as being funded through the Wisconsin Harbor Assistance Program is \$20,837 (20%); and

WHEREAS, the Three Year Harbor Development Statement of Intentions is used by the Wisconsin Department of Transportation for planning purposes only and is not a petition for federal and/or state aid; and

WHEREAS, the City of La Crosse is applying for a Harbor Assistance Program grant to fund municipal harbor improvements for Isle la Plume Dock Repairs; and

WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Department of Transportation requires a local resolution of support for the proposed project, executed by a governing body that has the authority to make financial commitment on behalf of the project sponsor; and


WHEREAS, the estimated cost of Isle La Plume Dock Repairs is \$104,186, 80% of which will be covered by the HAP grant, 20% of which will be covered by the City; additional improvements will be covered by Hanke Terminal.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of La Crosse that it hereby supports the City in applying for the Harbor Assistance Program Grant application for municipal harbor improvements at Hanke Terminal.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the 20% of the proposed project's cost in the amount of \$20,837 was identified within the five year plan in the 2018-2022 Capital Improvement Program budget for Isle La Plume improvements.
