AN ORDINANCE to amend Sub-section 115-110 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of La Crosse transferring certain property from the Traditional Neighborhood Development District to the Public/Semi-Public District.  
Property is presently used for: Vacant lot.  
Property is proposed to be used for: Fire station.  
Proposed zoning is necessary: Current zoning classification only allows residential development.
