Resolution authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to sign State/Municipal Agreement for the Citywide Traffic Implementation utilizing the Signal and ITS Standalone Program (Project I.D.s #3700-11-65).

## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City of La Crosse received SISP Funds to improve traffic signals on connecting highways by installing accessible pedestrian signals (APS). Pedestrian buttons at 43 intersections in the City of La Crosse will be upgraded to a new Public Right-of-Way Accessibility Guidelines (PROWAG) compliant push buttons. The installation will be performed over two years to reduce the impacts to the traveling public.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of La Crosse that the Mayor and City Clerk are authorized to sign the State/Municipal Agreement for the Citywide Traffic Implementation utilizing the Signal and ITS Standalone Program (Project I.D.s #3700-11-65).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the State/Municipal Agreement be referred to the 2026-2030 Capital Improvement Program for funding.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Engineering & Public Works and Finance Director hereby authorized to perform all duties to effectuate this resolution.
