## CITY OF LA CROSSE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS Findings & Orders:

August 16, 2023

() ESTABLISHING (X) AMENDING () VACATING

TYPE OF ALTERATION: Replace 2-Hour parking with No Parking Zone

GENERAL LOCATION: One No Parking zone on the East side of the 600 block of 8<sup>th</sup> Street S as defined below in the report section. Two additional No Parking zones on both sides of the 700 block of 8<sup>th</sup> St S as defined below in the report section.

## Report:

A request and application were received to investigate the 600 and 700 blocks of 8<sup>th</sup> Street S regarding removing portions of 2 Hour parking and installing four No Parking Zones to increase visibility of pedestrians crossing 8<sup>th</sup> Street. The application was received from the Executive Administrative Assistant of Viterbo University.

- East side of 600 block of 8<sup>th</sup> Street South, from the North line of Market Street to a point 50 feet northerly thereof.
- Both sides of 700 block from the South line of Market Street to a point 50 feet southerly thereof.

It is hereby noted that the University requesting the No Parking Zone constitutes 100% of the footage. It is therefore recommended to install the No Parking Zones in the 600 and 700 blocks of 8<sup>th</sup> Street S as defined above on the east and west sides of the street.

**WHEREAS**, Section 44-39 of the City of La Crosse Municipal Code of Ordinances provides that after obtaining a report and recommendation of the Traffic Engineer, the Chief of Police shall forward recommendations and appropriate orders to the Board of Public Works.

**AND WHEREAS**, the Findings of the Traffic Engineer state the public interest, convenience, and necessity, the Chief of Police hereby Orders the above traffic alterations, to wit:

• Establish No Parking Zones in the 600-700 blocks of 8th Street S, as defined above.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Board of Public Works hereby approves the aforementioned traffic alteration, and City staff is hereby authorized to effect said changes.
