RESOLUTION


WHEREAS, the City of La Crosse received SISF Funds to improve traffic signals on connecting highways by replacing end of life non-intrusive vehicle detection. Detection at 11 intersections in the City of La Crosse will be upgraded to a new non-intrusive detection system.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of La Crosse that the Mayor and City Clerk are authorized to sign the State/Municipal Agreement for the Citywide Traffic Implementation utilizing the Signal and ITS Standalone Program (Project I.D.s #3700-11-60).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the State/Municipal Agreement be referred to the 2025-2029 Capital Improvement Program for funding.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Engineering & Public Works and Finance Director hereby authorized to perform all duties to effectuate this resolution.
