

Resolution authorizing city finance and fire departments to establish a special revenue fund to fulfill obligations of Resolutions 26-0221 and 25-1472. (Tri State Ambulance Leased Employee Agreement and Local 127 MOU for Ambulance Transport Compensation)

#### RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City Council has approved resolutions 26-0221 and 25-1472; and

WHEREAS the adopted resolution identifies specific revenue from Tri State Ambulance in exchange for staffing and operating an ambulance on a full-time 24/7 basis; and

WHEREAS changes in compensation, base wage salaries, stipends, additional training, overtime, and backfill overtime are needed to fulfill the obligations of staffing the ambulance; and

WHEREAS the City of La Crosse Finance Department requires approval to establish an appropriate special revenue fund to effectively and efficiently manage the financial needs of both resolutions;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of La Crosse that both the Finance and Fire Departments shall be granted the ability to establish an appropriate special revenue fund to manage the financial obligations of the Tri State Ambulance leased employee agreement while meeting the Local 127 CBA MOU compensation requirements.

BE FURTHER RESOLVED, the special revenue fund and the obligations of the leased employee agreement will not impact the general fund and will be dedicated solely to the maintenance of the program and service agreements.

BE FURTHER RESOLVED, any excess funds collected above the need to fund the services will be returned to the general fund.

BE FURTHER RESOLVED, the Finance Director and Fire Chief be given authority to execute all elements of the resolution.
