

The following resolution was introduced by Council Member Medinger, and was read in full:

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-03-045

RESOLUTION directing the advertisement and sale of approximately \$5,400,000 aggregate principal amount of General Obligation Corporate Purpose Bonds, Series 2018, and approximately \$2,500,000 aggregate principal amount of General Obligation Promissory Notes, Series 2018 of the City of La Crosse, La Crosse County, Wisconsin.

WHEREAS, cities are authorized by Chapter 67 of the *Wisconsin Statutes*, as supplemented and amended, to borrow money and to issue bonds to finance any project undertaken for a public purpose and to refund municipal obligations, including interest thereon; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that funds be raised by the City of La Crosse, La Crosse County, Wisconsin (the “City”), in an approximate aggregate principal amount of \$5,400,000 for the purpose of acquiring, constructing and improving engine houses, fire protection apparatus and equipment, fire department equipment, library improvements, parks and public grounds and swimming pools, police parking facilities, storm sewer improvements, and streets, street lighting and street improvements; and

WHEREAS, it is considered necessary and desirable by the Common Council of the City that the City borrow money and issue its General Obligation Corporate Purpose Bonds, Series 2018 in an approximate aggregate principal amount of \$5,400,000 which may be issued in one or more series (the “Bonds”), for the purpose of acquiring, constructing and improving engine houses, fire protection apparatus and equipment, fire department equipment, library improvements, parks and public grounds and swimming pools, police parking facilities, storm sewer improvements, and streets, street lighting and street improvements for which initial resolutions have been adopted; and

WHEREAS, cities are authorized by the provisions of Section 67.12(12) of the *Wisconsin Statutes*, as supplemented and amended, to borrow money and issue promissory notes to finance

any project undertaken for a public purpose and to refund municipal obligations, including interest thereon; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that funds be raised by the City in an approximate aggregate principal amount of \$2,500,000 for the purpose of acquiring, constructing and improving alleys, storm sewer improvements, technology and other equipment for public buildings in the City and other public purposes, sidewalks, bicycle and pedestrian plan improvements, parking enforcement vehicles, transit vehicles, equipment and vehicles for the fire department, library equipment, equipment and vehicles for parks and public grounds, equipment and vehicles for the police department, and equipment and vehicles for maintenance of streets and highways in the City; and

WHEREAS, it is considered necessary and desirable by the Common Council of the City that the City borrow money and issue its General Obligation Promissory Notes, Series 2018 in an approximate aggregate principal amount of \$2,500,000, which may be issued in one or more series (the “Notes”), for the purpose of acquiring, constructing and improving alleys, storm sewer improvements, technology and other equipment for public buildings in the City and other public purposes, sidewalks, bicycle and pedestrian plan improvements, parking enforcement vehicles, transit vehicles, equipment and vehicles for the fire department, library equipment, equipment and vehicles for parks and public grounds, equipment and vehicles for the police department, and equipment and vehicles for maintenance of streets and highways in the City; and

WHEREAS, it is considered desirable to offer all of the Bonds and the Notes at one time or close in proximity of time in order to obtain the best possible terms for the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Common Council of the City of La Crosse, La Crosse County, Wisconsin, as follows:

Section 1. For the purpose of offering for sale the Bonds and the Notes, the City Clerk of the City is hereby authorized to cause an appropriate notice of the sale thereof to be published

in a newspaper to be selected by the City Clerk of the City. The City Clerk of the City shall also cause to be prepared and distributed an Official Statement, including Official Terms of Offering, with respect to the Bonds and the Notes.

Section 2. After bids shall have been received for the Bonds and the Notes, this Common Council will adopt additional proceedings to award the same to the best bidder or bidders, prescribe the terms thereof and the forms of Bond and Note, and will levy taxes in the specific amount necessary to pay the principal of and interest on the Bonds and the Notes.

Section 3. The Director of Finance and Purchasing/City Treasurer of the City is hereby authorized to cause some of the Bonds to be issued as Notes and to adjust the principal amounts of the Bonds and the Notes accordingly.

Section 4. The Mayor, the City Clerk, the Director of Finance and Purchasing/City Treasurer and all other officers of the City are hereby authorized to execute all documents and certificates necessary in connection with the sale of the Bonds and the Notes, including without limitation one or more official statements describing the Bonds and the Notes and the City.

Section 5. If any section, paragraph or provision of this Resolution shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Resolution.

Section 6. All ordinances and resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby superseded to the extent of such conflict, and this Resolution shall take effect from and after its passage.

**OFFICIAL NOTICE TO ELECTORS
OF ADOPTION OF
INITIAL RESOLUTIONS**

Initial resolutions were adopted at the regular meeting of the Common Council of the City of La Crosse, La Crosse County, Wisconsin, on March 8, 2018, and promptly recorded, providing for the issuance of general obligation bonds of the City in the amounts and for the public purposes, as follows:

AMOUNT	PURPOSE
\$1,365,000	engine houses and improvements, fire protection apparatus and equipment and other equipment for the fire department
55,000	library improvements
1,020,000	parks, public grounds and swimming pools
555,000	police parking facilities
410,000	storm sewer improvements
1,995,000	Streets, street lighting and street improvements

For the purpose of paying the various installments of principal of and interest on the aforesaid bonds as they severally mature, prior to their issuance and delivery there shall be levied on all taxable property in the City a direct annual irrevocable tax sufficient for that purpose.

The bonds authorized to be issued by the various Initial Resolutions set out above shall be issued by the City of La Crosse unless, before 5:00 P.M., on April 9, 2018, a petition is filed in the office of the City Clerk by electors numbering at least ten percent (10%) of the votes cast for governor in the City at the last general election requesting that the initial resolution be submitted to the electors.
