

**NOTICE OF HEARING ON
AMENDMENT TO ZONING RESTRICTION**

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Common Council of the City of La Crosse, by its Judiciary & Administration Committee, will hold a public hearing on a proposed ordinance change in the zoning code as follows:

AN ORDINANCE to amend Subsection 115-110 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of La Crosse transferring certain property from the Single Family District and Residence District to the Traditional Neighborhood District - General allowing a second multi-family residential apartment building at 1114 and 1120 5th Ave. S.

Proposed rezoning is necessary because: Existing zoning does not support multi-family or two buildings.

Said property is further described as follows:

17-30092-40. BURNS ADDITION LOT 9 & LOT 10 EX N 30FT 6IN BLOCK 7.

17-30092-30. BURNS ADDITION LOT 8 BLOCK 7.

A public hearing before the Judiciary & Administration Committee will be held at **6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, June 5, 2018** in the Council Chambers in City Hall, City of La Crosse, La Crosse County, Wisconsin.

Final action will be determined by the **Common Council on Thursday, June 14, 2018 at 6:00 p.m.** in the Council Chambers in City Hall, City of La Crosse, La Crosse County, Wisconsin.

Any person interested may be heard for or against such proposed change, and may appear in person, by attorney or may file a formal objection, which objection forms are available in the City Clerk's Office.

The petition and/or maps relating to the above referenced amendment may be examined in the Office of the City Clerk, 2nd floor City Hall, between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. on any regular business day, holidays excepted, or in the Legislative Information Center which can be accessed from the City website at www.cityoflacrosse.org.
