

Alley Vacation

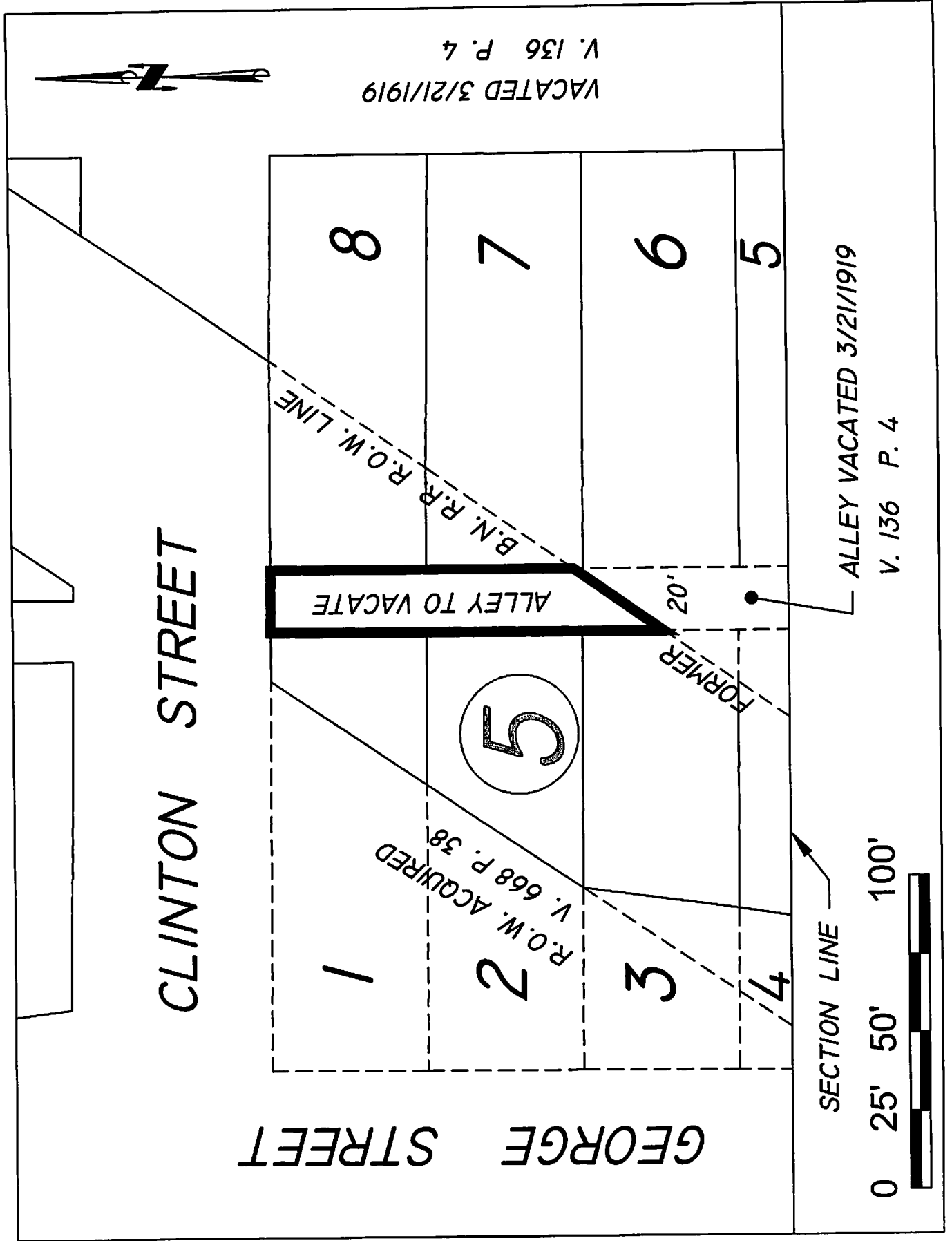
