

Resolution authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to sign State/Municipal Agreement for the Citywide Traffic Implementation utilizing the Signal and ITS Standalone Program (Project I.D.s #3700-10-88).

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City of La Crosse received SISP Funds to improve traffic signals on connecting highways by replacing aging signal cabinets. Traffic signal equipment at 18 intersections in the City of La Crosse will be upgraded, including 13 new traffic signal cabinets. An advanced traffic management system will also be procured, allowing the City of La Crosse to more efficiently monitor the traffic signals at these locations.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of La Crosse that the Mayor and City Clerk are authorized to sign the State/Municipal Agreement for the Citywide Traffic Implementation utilizing the Signal and ITS Standalone Program (Project I.D.s #3700-10-88).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the State/Municipal Agreement be referred to the 2021-2025 Capital Improvement Program for funding.
