Dear Mr. Gilman:

On behalf of our team, I am very pleased to present to you this Expression of Interest and Qualification Statement for the remarkable Riverside North Development in La Crosse, Wisconsin. Our team is profoundly excited to have the opportunity to present our qualifications and experience to you for your consideration. Attached to this Letter of Interest and Qualification Statement we have included biographies for each of our development team members as well as information regarding our current development activities that may be particularly pertinent for this specific development opportunity.

WiRED Properties is a Milwaukee-based real estate development and consulting firm. Founded 10 years ago, the company is dedicated to community creation through dynamic, creative and engaging real estate developments. We have deep experience in working on urban sites with meaningful environmental challenges and we have executed developments ranging from the renovation of single historic buildings to large-scale master-planned developments. Above all, we have executed mixed-use real estate developments that focus on the quality and character of the pedestrian environment and on adding value to the local community through public amenities, local retail and the quality and enduring character of the architecture.

We believe that our team is perfectly suited to partner with the City of La Crosse in the planning and execution of this development. We embrace a deeply collaborative approach with our public partners and we believe that the ultimate success of the development will be determined by the ability of the public and private team members to creatively solve for both the technical planning issues associated with the development and fundamental local market considerations that can contribute to mixed-use success.

Two of our current developments bear substantial similarities to the opportunity presented in La Crosse:

WiRED Properties was selected by the City of Oak Creek, Wisconsin to act as their lead development partner in the creation of their new downtown at Drexel Town Square. Located on the 80-acre site of a former Delphi / AC Delco manufacturing site, Drexel Town Square is a remarkable master-planned development that is re-inventing the municipality.

Drexel Town Square can be considered as two separate developments. One is an approximate 40-acre site that is suburban big-box anchored in character. The second half is truly compelling. WiRED was brought onto the team to act as a primary development consultant in the planning of the overall site concept, and to act as the at-risk developer of the new two-block long Main Street. The overall Town Square portion of the development includes an ~13-acre wetlands park, a hotel, a new

city hall and library, ~450 units of multifamily, an ~110,000 square foot multi-disciplinary medical facility and a new Main Street.

WiRED is completing its first phase now: an ~\$20,000,000 development including ~33,000 square feet of ground floor retail and 62 upper floor apartments in two buildings flanking Main Street. Our second phase will include another ~20,000 square feet of commercial space with a third phase to complete Main Street to be comprised of ~10,000 square feet of retail.

We believe Drexel Town Square presents strong evidence of our team's dedicated ability to collaborate and partner with a municipality to optimize the outcome for both parties as well as for the community at large. We invite you to speak to Mayor Stephen Scaffidi or City Administrator Gerald Peterson at the City of Oak Creek to better understand the role we have played in their remarkable development.

The second current development that we believe presents our specific qualifications is Ballpark Commons in Franklin, Wisconsin. Several years ago Mike Zimmerman engaged the City of Franklin and Milwaukee County in conversations regarding the activation and development of a parcel of land that had historically been a landfill. Through remarkable public/private collaboration and dedicated efforts, Mike was able to create a baseball and outdoor activity driven community. Comprised of a ski and tubing hill (previously existing), four major league stadium replica state-of-the-art little league fields, two more softball fields, an umbrella bar and more, The Rock Sports Complex now boasts over 150,000 annual visitors.

The Rock, and now Ballpark Commons, are a located on a deeply complicated site. It includes such environmental conditions as wetlands and landfill and it is located on an assemblage of land that includes City, County, WisDOT and WDNR jurisdictions.

Today, our team has received General Development Plan approvals for a substantial addition to that community. Our approved plans, construction of the first phases of which will start in 2017, include an ~39-acre parcel immediately south of The Rock that will include ~300 units of apartments, 25,000 square feet of commercial and a hotel. Across the street and generally on the same parcel as The Rock, we have proposed to build an earthen-berm minor league baseball stadium that will be home to the University of Wisconsin – Milwaukee baseball team as well as a minor league team to be owned by Mike Zimmerman. In addition, we will be developing three sports/entertainment buildings including an indoor baseball training facility, an indoor family entertainment center and a state-of-the-art golf facility. We have also planned for an additional 100,000 square feet of mixed commercial (retail and office) space and up to an additional 100 apartments flanking a new main street.

In short, we believe our team is perfectly suited to partner with the City of La Crosse in your remarkable development opportunity at Riverside North. Each of our principals can be available to meet with you and your team (with the exception of June 15-22). I very much look forward to meeting you.




