ORDINANCE NO.: 4870  
AN ORDINANCE to create Section 40-4(c) and (d), Section 2-2(24), and Section 2-3(15) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of La Crosse regarding bond and insurance needed for driveway installation.  
THE COMMON COUNCIL of the City of La Crosse do ordain as follows:  
SECTION I: Subsection 40-4(c) and (d) are hereby created to read as follows:  
(c) Bond. Prior to issuance of a permit, the applicant must furnish a bond as required in Section 2-3.  
(d) Insurance. Prior to issuance of a permit, the applicant must furnish insurance as required in Section 2-2.  
SECTION II: Section 2-2(24) is hereby created to read as follows:  
(24) Insurance. Permittees shall carry comprehensive General Li-

bility Insurance and completed Operations Insurance, which insurance shall include all work provided for by the permit whether such work be by the permittee or by any subcontractor or by anyone directly or indirectly employed by any of them or by anyone for whose acts any of them may be liable, with a minimum combined single limit of \$500,000.00 for bodily injury and property damage per occurrence. The insurance required shall be written by insurance companies who are rated "B" or better in Best's Key Rating Guide and shall be licensed to do business in the State of Wisconsin. Certificates of Insurance naming the City of La Crosse as additional insured shall be filed with the Engineering Department before any permit shall be issued and shall also provide for thirty (30) days' notice prior to expiration, cancellation or material change to be sent to the Engineering Department.

SECTION III: Section 2-3(15) is hereby created to read as follows:  
(15) Bond. Before a permit for driveway installation may be issued, the applicant must execute and deposit with the Engineering Department an Indemnity Bond approved by the Director of Finance/Treasurer in the sum of \$5,000.00 conditioned that the applicant will replace in good condition all driveway identi-
