application by Barrett Klein of 1632 Park Ave.

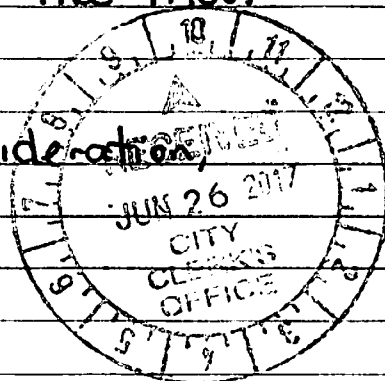
This letter is to express my hearty
