Dear La Crosse Common Council Members,

I am writing to express support for Alternative 1, which includes protected bike lanes on 3rd and 4th Streets.

This project reflects AARP's transportation policy, which calls on local governments to ensure the safety of all road users—inside and outside vehicles—through road design, infrastructure, and planning.
