

# Background


- Strategic Plan for Sustainability in 2009

- 2019 Resolution to be carbon neutral by 2050
- 2020-22 Energy Action Plan with Utility
- Climate Action Plan adopted in January 2025 (50% greenhouse gas emission reduction by 2030)

On behalf of the City of La Crosse, I am proud to announce our commitment to becoming a Charging Smart-designated community. In partnership with the Charging Smart team, La Crosse's dedicated staff members will work to accelerate local adoption of EVs and EV charging. La Crosse will collaborate with the Charging Smart program to develop best practices that serve the community's EV charging needs.

La Crosse will leverage Charging Smart to achieve the following goals related to EVs and EV charging:

- Create EV-friendly building codes.
- Create an EV charger siting guide that includes ADA compliance.
- Increase electric vehicle use to 20% of community-wide rolling stock by 2030.

These efforts demonstrate that our community is committed to making continual improvement in our community's EV readiness, and in the process of doing so, all the related areas identified as community priorities in our Climate Action Plan.

To measure progress along the way, La Crosse will track key metrics related to EV and infrastructure deployment.
