

Bartender / Taxi License Qualifications

Applicants must meet the following qualifications to obtain a bartenders/taxi license:

The Police Chief shall consider the following factors when making a recommendation to approve or deny an operator's license:

- 1. A history of alcohol related convictions (3 or more in the past 10 years) for bartender applicants.
- 2. May not be a "habitual law offender". The term "habitual" refers to multiple convictions.
- 3. Any outstanding warrants, open or pending cases through any court and any unpaid fines.
- 4. May not have been convicted of a felony which substantially relates to the licensing activity.
- 5. A history of driving related convictions for taxi applicants.
- 6. Any misleading or falsified applications.
