NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the change in position classification, job title and compensation listed below is hereby approved as follows:

Delete one (1) exempt vacant position of Housing Rehab Specialist, pay grade 11 – step 10 hourly rate of \$34.00.

Delete one (1) non-exempt position of Assistant Housing Rehab Specialist, pay grade 9 – step 4, with 2014 hourly rate of 24.95. Change incumbent to new non-exempt position of Housing Specialist, pay grade 10, step 7 2014 hourly rate of \$29.00.

Add one (1) additional non-exempt position of Housing Specialist, pay grade 10, step 4 hourly rate of \$26.69.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the position titles, classifications and salary identified herein are hereby approved effective June 12, 2015. The Director of Finance, Director of Human Resources and the Interim Director of Planning and Development are hereby authorized and directed to take all necessary steps to implement this resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that funding for the new positions is available in the 2015 Planning Operating Budget HUD.
