NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Common Council of the City of La Crosse, by its Judiciary & Administration Committee, will hold a public hearing on a proposed ordinance change in the zoning code as follows:

AN ORDINANCE to amend Sub-section 115-110 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of La Crosse transferring certain property from the Single Family Dwelling District to the Public/Semi-Public District allowing new fire station 1533 Charles Street.

Property is presently used for: Single family home.

Property is proposed to be used for: New fire station.

Rezoning is necessary because: A fire station is not an approved use in current zoning.

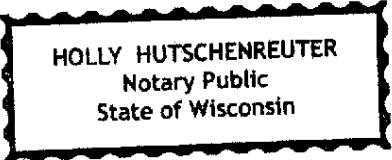
