**Applicants must meet the following qualifications to
obtain a bartenders/taxi license:**

The Police Chief shall consider the following factors when making a recommendation to approve or deny an operator's license:

1. A history of alcohol related convictions (3 or more in the past 10 years) for bartender applicants.
2. May not be a "habitual law offender". The term "habitual" refers to multiple convictions.
3. Any outstanding warrants, open or pending cases through any court and any unpaid fines.
4. May not have been convicted of a felony which substantially relates to the licensing activity.
5. A history of driving related convictions for taxi applicants.
6. Any misleading or falsified applications.
