If this sidewalk serves to protect just one child from harm by automobile or bus traffic the council has served the public interest. This sidewalk will indeed protect many more children.


Please keep the sidewalk and vote "No" on reconsideration.

Hello, I have already contacted some of you by e-mail about my concerns of putting a sidewalk in on the 1400 block of North Salem Rd, south side of the street. I thought it best that each of you have the same information. My name is Charlene Wegner, my husband Rick and I purchased our home at 2531 Prospect St, November 2005, and recently a resolution was approved to put a sidewalk in on the north side of our home.

Rick and I have concerns about putting a sidewalk on the north side of our home because the sidewalk will be approximately 5-6 feet from the windows of both of our bedrooms. My husband works out of town all summer, so I am home alone and like to have the windows open at night, when weather permits. I would be concerned with my safety if a sidewalk would be so close to my bedroom windows.

When we purchased our home, there was a sprinkler system and we would have to spend hundreds of dollars to have this moved, additional lines and sprinkler heads installed so our entire yard, including the boulevard would be maintained to our standards and if you have seen our yard, those standards are very high.

I was very upset by the approval of the sidewalk and voiced my concerns to Council Member Richmond because she did not contact my husband or I, or the neighbor at 2532 Loomis St about the proposed sidewalk and find out what, if any concerns we had. The first I had heard about the sidewalk was when Dave Karl, one of the City Engineers, contacted me. After contacting Ms. Richmond, my next call was to Mayor Harter and after talking to Ms Richmond; he has agreed to contact the Engineering Department to put a hold on it, until we were able to work on a motion to reconsider.

In the almost five years we have lived at our residence, we have never heard any concerns, nor had anyone make a comment about a need for a sidewalk at our location. There is a sidewalk on the north side of the street. We have heard many comments about how well maintained, and beautiful our yard, flowers and pond look. There are several reasons we purchased our house, but the things we loved about the yard was that there was not a sidewalk on the north side of the street, and second (more so for me than Rick) was the sprinkler system. We also loved the openness of the yard, neither

of us wanted a fence because we like watching the beauty and activity of the neighborhood. We often have neighbors and others we know stop by when we are outside to visit.

I have contacted Andrea Richmond and explained our concerns to her and due to the circumstances, she was not aware of she has agreed to support a motion to reconsider and apologized for not looking into the situation further. Council member Chris Olson has agreed to contact Teri Lehrke and get the proposal started. I would appreciate your support in the motion to reconsider regarding the sidewalk on the south side of 1400 block of North Salem Rd on June 10th council meeting.

I have an open invitation to you all to stop by our home to observe our concerns and to ask any questions. I have contacted all of you so you have as much information as possible to make an informed decision on this motion.

I appreciate your time and support and look forward to meeting and thanking you on June 10th.
