

Report of Quote & Resolution awarding contract to Fowler & Hammer, Inc. in the amount of \$11,715.65 for the Crowley Place Median Retrofit contract.

RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of La Crosse that the quote in the amount of \$11,715.65 of Fowler & Hammer, Inc. on the 13th day of May, 2021 for the performance of the following public work, to wit:

CROWLEY PLACE MEDIAN RETROFIT

being the lowest responsible bid based upon the project specifications as finally accepted by the Common Council, be and the same is hereby accepted.

WHEREAS, per Division 3-Section 2-360 of the City Code of Ordinances, approval of this project requires two thirds vote of the Common Council members present as it was not listed in a previously adopted Capital Improvement Plan. The source of funds shall be a donation of full costs, a lump sum in the amount of \$25,000, from the PMG Foundation.

BE IT RESOLVED that a contract in the amount of \$11,715.65, the Common Council of the City of La Crosse hereby appropriated and ordered paid out of the following:

BE IT RESOLVED that the amount of \$1,757.34, the Common Council of the City of La Crosse hereby appropriated and ordered paid out of the following:



as and for a Contingency Fund for such public work with the Board of Public Works authorized to make the necessary changes in said contract that the circumstances may warrant and to pay for such changes from such Contingency Fund, all in accordance with the terms in the City of La Crosse Contract Volume.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Engineering Department is authorized to direct purchase any material and/or equipment it deems to be in the best interest of the City. This should be an amount not to exceed \$11,527.01.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the contract is made, executed and delivered in the name of the City of La Crosse, Wisconsin.
