AN ORDINANCE to amend Sub-section 115-110 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of La Crosse transferring certain property from the Single Family District and Residence District to the Traditional Neighborhood District - General allowing use as commercial, mix use or multi-family development at 618 Jackson St. and 1004 7th St. S.
