AMENDED RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Common Council and the La Crosse Professional Police Non-Supervisory Association agreed to a memorandum of understanding providing that officers providing security services shall be paid a straight hourly rate for voluntary work assignments to provide security services for the civic center, schools and other requests for security which may be mutually agreed upon between the Chief of Police and the Association President,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of La Crosse that there is hereby appropriated the sum of <sup>46,000</sup>~~20,000~~ from the Surplus Fund to be placed in a Revolving Fund in connection with the providing of said services as approved by the Chief of Police.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

WHEREAS, certain police officers represented by the La Crosse Professional Police Non-Supervisory Association participate in voluntary work assignments to provide security services for the Civic Center, schools and other requests for security which shall be mutually agreed upon between the Chief of Police and the Association President or his designee,

WHEREAS, such community activity managers must request and seek approval for such services from the Chief of the La Crosse Police Department prior to any voluntary assignments,

WHEREAS, persons volunteering for such assignments shall be selected on a seniority basis,

WHEREAS, such approved requests shall be posted, including the name of the event, the date, time and place and the number of hours to be worked,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that such officers providing security services shall be paid straight time hourly rate for the top patrol classification without pay differential, and further, that such officers shall be paid from the City's regular payroll account and as such receive fringe benefits usually associated with such payment.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that overtime provisions in the work agreement between the Association and the City be hereby waived for the above voluntary work assignments.
