

Resolution Authorizing Public Improvement and Levying Special Assessments Against Benefited Property in La Crosse, Wisconsin. RESOLUTION WHEREAS, Resolution 15-0379 adopted by the Common Council on May 14, 2015 approved the construction for an alley on the 600 Block South between 2nd and 3rd Streets and directed the alley assessment process for the alley to occur.

It is expedient and necessary and for the best interest of the City of La It is expedient and necessary and for the best interest of the City of La Crosse and for the property affected thereby, that Alley Pavement be constructed in the 600 S. block between 2nd and 3rd Streets, in the Vicinity of 614, 3rd Street, 624 3rd street, and 200 Cameron Ave; to be improved at the expense of the property benefited by the construction of new alley pavement.

The Council exercises its police power to lew special assessments upon property for benefits conferred upon such property.

The Walvers of Special Assessment Notices and Hearings, incor-

Payment for the improvements shall be made by assessing against the premises for the cost of the Public improvements; provided, how-ever that the amount of such spe-cial assessments against the property shall not exceed that shown on the attached assessment roll.

Assessments shown represent an exercise of the police power for the health, safety and general welfare of the City and its inhabitants and have been determined on a reasonable

basis and are hereby confirmed.
Assessments are due upon construction of said alley pavement. Asstruction of said alley pavernent. As-sessments may be paid in cash or shall be payable over a period of ten years or fifteen years to the City Treasurer. Installments shall be placed on the next tax roll after the due date for collection and shall bear interest at the rate established by the Council per annum on the un-paid balance from January 1st of the
