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ORDINANCE NO.: 5155
 AN AMENDED ORDINANCE to amend Section 2-422(c)(6) and Section 2-422(d), (e) and (f) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of La Crosse regarding residency requirements on boards, commissions and committees.
 THE COMMON COUNCIL of the City of La Crosse do ordain as follows:
 SECTION I: Section 2-422(c)(6) is hereby amended to read as follows:
 (6) Sustainable La Crosse Commission in accordance with division 10 Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee in accordance with Resolution No. 19-1807.
 SECTION II: Section 2-422(d), (e) and (f) are hereby amended to read as follows:
 (d) Notwithstanding the provisions contained herein, and in accordance with Resolution 2006-05-047, up to four members of the City of La Crosse Arts Board may be non-residents. In the event the member from the La Crosse County Board of Supervisors lives outside the City limits, such member shall constitute one of the four non-resident members.
 (e) Notwithstanding the provisions contained herein, the Animal Control Governing Board may consist of up to four non-resident members in compliance with the Animal Control Agreement.
 (f) Subsection (a) and (b) of this section shall not apply to City employees or other technical staff where their expertise is essential to the board, commission or committee.
 (f) Notwithstanding subsection (a), the Mayor may reappoint, subject to Council confirmation, the non-resident for the residue of the non-resident's term after a vacancy is created by application of subsection (a). This subsection shall not apply to governing bodies where residency is required by authority other than subsection (a).
 SECTION III: Should any portion of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this division shall not be affected.
 SECTION IV: This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication.
