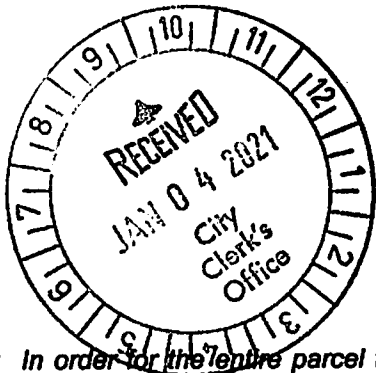
I/We hereby object to the amendment to the Zoning Code by the transfer of the following described land (include address and tax parcel number from Notice of Hearing): \_\_\_\_\_

from the residential District to the parking lot District.

I/We object for the following reason(s): \_\_\_\_\_  
The existing two story structure which formerly housed the Coulee Council on Addictions serves as a physical buffer between the traffic, noise, and bright lights of the West and Jackson intersection and the residential interior of the entire block extending north and east from Taco John's. Those shady, peaceful backyards are currently a huge asset to the livability of this urban neighborhood and the neon and noise that would flood our outdoor living spaces without a physical structure at 921 West Ave. S. would negatively effect all of the property values on the block. In addition, the city should not be allowing a second lane of drive-through fast food traffic with the noise and exhaust of idling motors so near residential properties. I ask instead that the city restrict current drive through traffic from entering or exiting through our residential alley, and insist that Taco John's build a fence on the current alley line.
