WHEREAS, the County has owned the property for a period of time and is required to maintain the property; and,


WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the County of La Crosse to deed such property to the City of La Crosse so that the property can be maintained by the City of La Crosse; and,


WHEREAS, the City of La Crosse has indicated that the City is agreeable to receiving the property.
