

Resolution authorizing the Interim Transit Manager to enter into a contract with Gillig Corporation for the purchase of four (4) transit buses.

### RESOLUTION

WHEREAS the Municipal Transit Utility is in need of replacing four (4) transit buses that have exceeded their useful life, and

WHEREAS the Municipal Transit Utility is using Wisconsin Department of Transportation's bus procurement RFP #510011, and

WHEREAS there are Federal funds in a 2013 5339 State of Good Repair Grant in the amount of \$699,000 for transit bus purchases, and

WHEREAS there is Federal funds in a 2014 5307 (transfer from STP-Urban grant) in the amount of \$360,000 for transit bus purchases.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of La Crosse that it hereby authorizes the Director of Finance and the Municipal Transit Utility to purchase four (4) 35-foot diesel low floor buses.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Interim Transit Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Gillig Corporation for the purchase of said buses.

BE IT FURTHER REOSLVED the cost of each bus is \$412,000 plus a \$5,000 contingency each for a total of \$417,000 per bus.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the sum of \$1,668,000 is hereby appropriated as follows:

- \$688,000.00 - Federal Funds (2013 5339 State of Good Repair Grant)
- \$360,000.00 - Federal Funds (2014 5307, transfer from STP-Urban Grant)
- \$18,044.14 - 2011 CIP Transit New Capital Equipment
- \$344,000.00 - 2013 CIP Transit New Capital Equipment
- \$176,000.00 - 2014 CIP Transit New Capital Equipment
- \$373,830.56 - 2016 CIP Transit New capital Equipment

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Interim Transit Manager and Director of Finance and Purchase, or his/her representative, are authorized to take any and all steps necessary to effectuate this resolution.
