Cakes Demonstration Plan

The purpose of the demonstration is to evaluate the performance of these fireworks cakes. This area of Isle la Plume is an ideal location for demonstrations because it is closed to the public and is mostly sand.

The plan is to fire 10 - 1" 16 shot Consumer Fireworks (1.4G) Cakes, 8 during the day and 2 after dark, with variations in their configuration and placement.

The timing is weather and city employee access dependent, thus the wide time windows 3:00 PM to 10:00 PM on April 3rd and 8:00 AM to Noon on April 4th. *If employees are working in this area, firing will be suspended until they are finished.*

Actual firing time should be 15 minutes during the day and 3 minutes after dark.

Pressurized water extinguishers along with brooms in water buckets will be stationed at all 4 points, with Personnal stationed 3 points (minimum).

All personnel will wear ANSI rated safety glasses and hard hats, along with long sleeved natural fiber clothing.

Lexan shields will also be used.


