It has come to our attention that you may not comply with the residency requirements as agent on the Combination "Class B" Beer and Liquor license issued to Latino Bar and Grill LLC for premise located at 115 5th Ave. S., La Crosse.

Pursuant to La Crosse Municipal Code sec. 4-75, "*Corporations and their agents shall meet the requirements of Wis. Stat. ch. 125 and, in addition, the agents of corporate licensees shall have resided within the State of Wisconsin continuously for 90 days prior to the date of application and shall reside within a 25-mile radius of the City at the time of application and at all times such agent shall be the appointed agent for the corporation*".

As compliance with residency requirements is mandatory for maintaining the alcohol license, we require your written response and substantiating documentation to confirm your residency status. This response must be submitted within **15 days** from the date of this letter. Failure to respond within the specified timeframe may result in further review or action regarding your license.

If you no longer qualify as agent on the above-mentioned license, licensee Latino Bar and Grill LLC is required to appoint a successor agent immediately.

Additionally, the Wisconsin Department of Financial Institutions have posted a Notice of Administrative Dissolution warning for Latino Bar and Grill LLC. Please advise as to the status of this entity. If this LLC is dissolved, it is no longer eligible to hold an alcohol license.
