Resolution authorizing the creation of a revolving alternative fuel fund for the Police Department.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the La Crosse Police Department has been a leader in developing a program of alternative fuel use for the patrol fleet; and

WHEREAs, the La Crosse Police Department has a fleet of approximately 14 patrol vehicles that operate using propane fuel; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department is eligible to receive federal and state tax fuel credits for using alternative fuels such as propane; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department would like to expand the alternative fuel program to other fleet vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department currently has no mechanism or revolving account in place to allow the re-investment of tax credits into the propane fuel program in order to purchase, repair, and maintain propane fuel and equipment.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of La Crosse that the Council hereby authorizes the Police Department to create a committed special revolving revenue fund for the revenues and expenses for alternative fuels.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor, Police Chief, and Finance Director are hereby authorized to take any and all steps necessary to effectuate this resolution.
