Such proposed change set forth in the ordinance now pending before the Common Council of the City of La Crosse is as follows:

AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 115-110 of the Code of Ordinance of the City of La Crosse by transferring certain property from the Commercial District to the Washburn Residential District.

Address: 1021-1023 4th St. S.

Proposed Use: Residential – single family home.

Proposed Rezoning is Necessary Because: The entire structure will be residential.
