Provides that: If an owner filed a single family/Washburn registration under Ordinance #4764 & 4793 between the dates of July 1, 2013 through the date of publication, then those registrants will be able to receive a registration certificate under Ordinance #4810 at an initial fee of zero dollars for the registration year of July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2015.
