

THREE-MONTH EXTENSION OF ANIMAL CONTROL AGREEMENT

This extension of the current Animal Control Agreement ("Agreement") is entered into this day of , 2021 between the **City of La Crosse**, (hereinafter referred to as "City") and the **Coulee Region Humane Society, Inc.**, (hereinafter referred to as "Humane Society").

WHEREAS, the City and the Humane Society entered into an animal control agreement which expires on December 31, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the Humane Society desires to continue to provide animal control services within the City of La Crosse; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this Agreement is to extend the current agreement until such time as a new agreement can be entered into.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS AGREED between the parties as follows:

1. **Duration.** The duration of this Agreement shall be for three (3) months commencing January 1, 2022 and terminating on March 31, 2022.
2. **Terms.** All of the terms and conditions shall remain the same as the agreement expiring on December 31, 2021.



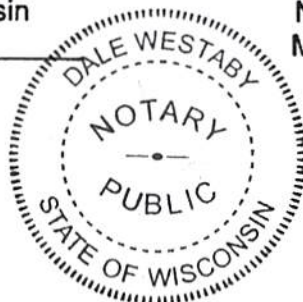

Resolution approving three-month extension of the Animal Control Agreement.


RESOLUTION
