

Resolution creating Wards 31-34.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Section 5.15(6)(a), Wis. Stats., provides that no ward line may cross the boundaries of an assembly district, and

WHEREAS, various property known as City-owned land and Strupp Trucking/Kwik Trip were annexed from the Towns of Medary and Shelby and are within the 94th Assembly District, and

WHEREAS, adjacent properties in the City limits are located within the 95th Assembly District, and

WHEREAS, Section 5.40(3)(a), Wis. Stats. provides that the municipality may elect to utilize paper ballots instead of voting machines, so long as the number of electors residing in the territory does not exceed 100.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of La Crosse that this Council's previous resolution adopted July 14, 2011 be and the same is hereby amended to provide for the creation of wards 31-34 due to the annexation of various properties as depicted on the attached, to be effective January 1, 2016 when the mid-decade redistricting takes effect.

Parcels B, C, D, E, F, G & H	Ward 31	2 nd Aldermanic District
Parcel I	Ward 32	3 rd Aldermanic District
Parcels N, O & P	Ward 33	13 th Aldermanic District
Strupp Trucking/Kwik Trip	Ward 34	2 nd Aldermanic District

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that except as otherwise amended, the aforesaid Council resolution establishing various wards within the City of La Crosse be and the same is in full force and effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the wards shall be assigned to the following polling places for the City of La Crosse to facilitate using a common polling place:

31 st & 34 th Ward	Harry J Olson Senior Citizen Center, 1607 North St.
32 nd Ward	Myrick Park Center, 789 Myrick Park Dr.
33 rd Ward	Good Shepherd Lutheran Church, 4141 Mormon Coulee Rd.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of La Crosse that the use of paper ballots is hereby authorized for these wards at the discretion of the clerk.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon adoption of this resolution, the City Clerk is authorized to send a copy of same to the La Crosse County Clerk and the Legislative Reference Bureau in accordance with Wis. Stat., sec. 5.15(4)(b).
