## **BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

The subject Ordinance would transfer the property depicted on attached MAP PC16-0057 from the C2-Commercial District to the WR-Washburn Residential District. The applicant is requesting a rezoning in order to renovate the property into a single family home. The building is currently duplexed with one unit vacant, and previously used as office space, and the other being used as an apartment. Washburn Residential was recommended by staff in order to be consistent with surrounding zoning.

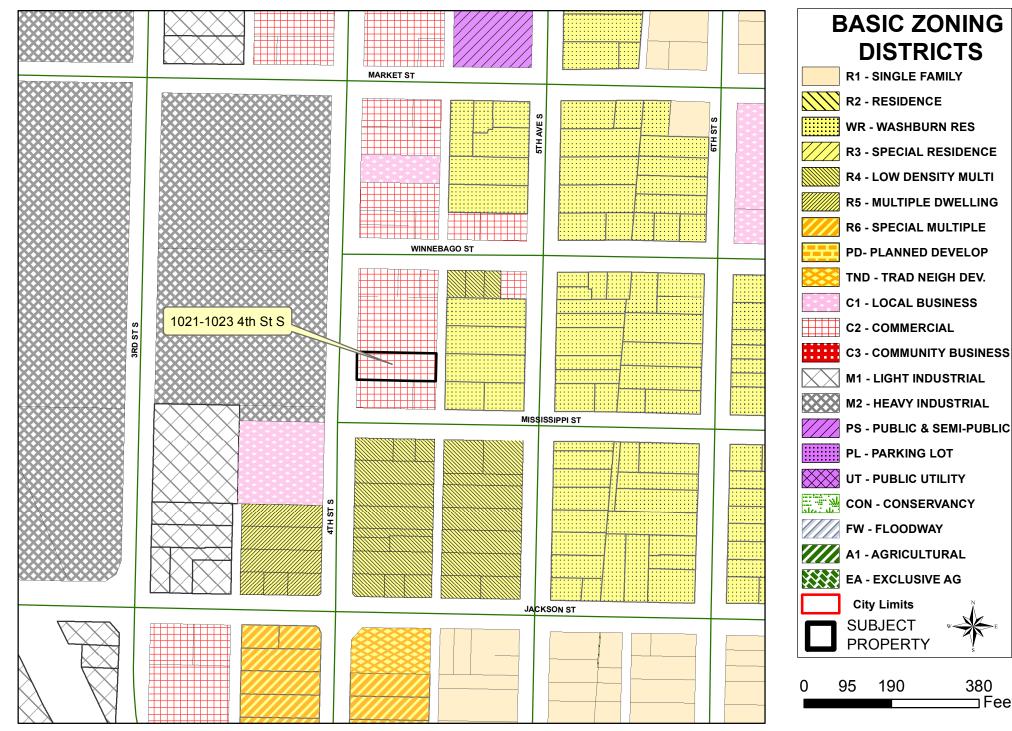
