City of La Crosse do ordain as follows:

SECTION I: Section 10.03(R) is hereby amended to read as follows:

(R) ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.

(1) No person shall have in his or her possession, custody or control any alcoholic beverages of any kind whatsoever, in any City playground, City swimming pool, designated public swimming area, or on park Riverside Park, Neighborhood Park, City synthin one thousand (1,000) feet of any school building, play structures, Riverside Park or public property within one thousand (1,000) feet of any school building, play structures, Riverside Park or public beach located in or near a City Park.

(12) Exceptions: Alcohol beverages will be are allowed at City of La Crosse Parks and Recreation Sports sponsored events at City parks, sport fields; Aalcoholic beverages will be allowed when reserving park facilities, pavilions and picnic shelters and indicating on the reservation form that alcoholic beverages will be at the event, the reservation is for, and Aalcoholic beverages will be are allowed by Special Event Leases Licenses or Agreements between the Board of Park Commissioners and the entity sponsoring the event.
