Application of 4 Sisters Catering on 4th, Inc. for a Conditional Use Permit at 133 4th St. S. allowing permission to apply for a Combination "Class B" Beer & Liquor license.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

4 Sister Catering on 4th Inc. have requested a conditional use permit for the adaptive reuse of the structure at 133 4th Street S. (formerly Consumers Bakery) and depicted on **MAP PC15-0843**. The applicant is requesting the permit to construct a catering business, bar and "light menu" restaurant on the first floor, requiring a Class B Beer and Liquor license. Per the applicants submittals, the bar and restaurant portion would only occupy the front first floor of the building, with the catering business in the rear of the first floor.

The rest of the three story structure will remain, mixed use with 2nd story apartments.

GENERAL LOCATION:

The structure is located at 133 4th Street (formerly Consumers Bakery).
