SUBJECT: PROPOSED SIDEWALK INSTALLATION ON THE WEST SIDE OF MILSON COURT.

THE FOLLOWING RESIDENTS OF MILSON COURT ARE AGAINST THE INSTALLATION. SOME OF THE REASONS ARE LISTED BELOW:

- Milson Court is the only road into Hixon Forest and it's beautiful hiking trails. Both sides of the street (668 feet long) have many older trees that enhance this entrance to Hixon Forest. The sidewalk proposed, would require removal of many of these trees.
- This sidewalk would be a sidewalk to nowhere as it would end at the last property on Milson Court and force people to go into the mudhole that exists on the dirt road/ hiking trail for approximately half a mile to the parking lot.
- The De Bauce property at 903 Milson Court, has a tuck under garage with a driveway that tapers down approximately 8 feet starting at the curb. This would require a complete new driveway to allow access to his garage.
- The existing property line on my property (919 Milson) is 80 inches from the curb. This would leave the space between the curb and the sidewalk at approximately 8 inches. The snowplow would put all the street snow on my sidewalk. Not a liveable situation.
- At a time when La Crosse taxes are 30 to 50 percent higher than the area towns and cities why would we want to add this costly project to the La Crosse city budget.
- I would propose a Bike Lane on the west side of the street for pedestrian and bikes as a low cost and far more common sense solution.
