

Resolution approving Harbor's Three-Year Statement of Intention to Wisconsin Department of Transportation 2020-2022.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Three Year Harbor Development Statement of Intentions describes proposed improvements which are in the best interest of the City of La Crosse; and

WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Department of Transportation, in accord with state statute, requires a statement of project intentions from local units of government intending to apply for federal and/or state aid for harbor related work of any type within the next three years; and


WHEREAS, we have carefully reviewed the estimated project costs, funding sources, physical location, and alternatives to the proposed project(s); and

WHEREAS, the total local matching funds required for projects indicated as being funded through the Wisconsin Harbor Assistance Program ranges from \$860,000 (20%) to \$2,150,000 (50%); and

WHEREAS, this Three Year Harbor Development Statement of Intentions is used by the Wisconsin Department of Transportation for planning purposes only and is not a petition for federal and/or state aid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of La Crosse that it hereby approves the Harbor Development Statement of Intentions 2020-2022.
