The Council exercises its police

power to levy special assessments upon property for benefits conferred

upon such property.

The report of the Board of Public Works, incorporated herein as if fully set forth herein, including the plans and specifications and assessments set forth therein, is adopted and ap-

The Board of Public Works shall advertise for bids and supervise to construction of the improvements in accordance with the report hereby adopted and take study other and expert steps to effectuate this resource. proved proper steps to effectuate this resolution.

Payment for the improvements shall be made by assessing the entire cost to the property benefited as

indicated in the report.

The Council determines that assessments shown on the report represent an exercise of the police power for the health, safety and general welfare of the City and its in-habitants and have been deter-mined on a reasonable basis and

are hereby confirmed.

Assessments may be paid in cash or shall be payable over a period of ten years or fifteen years to the City Treasurer. Installments shall be placed on the next tax roll after the due date for collection and shall bear interest at the rate established by the Council per annum on the unpaid balance from January 1st of the year following the levy.

The City Clerk shall provide notices in accordance with City Ord. 38-1.
