The Committee discussed whether or not the basketball court project could proceed without CDBG funding and with the \$33,000 already committed to the project from City funds. It was decided it could and additional

needs in the park could be met through savings on the basketball project. The Committee debated whether or not to split the award of the TBRA vouchers or fund only one organization. Funding to Red Cloud project is contingent on successfully obtaining all other proposed sources of financing and lowering developers fees. The Impact 7 project was funded at half the requested amount and they were encouraged to lower their construction costs. Funding for TBRA contingent on Catholic Charities and Couleecap working together.
