AN ORDINANCE to amend Sub-section 115-110 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of La Crosse transferring certain property from the Light Industrial District to the Commercial District allowing a brewery/taiproom at 83 Copeland Avenue.
Proposed rezoning is necessary because: Current light industrial zoning does not allow for proposed use.
